



## Kevin and Diane Denning

Kevin and Diane Denning are Round Dance Cuers and Instructors residing in Wichita, Kansas. They were married September 1, 1984 and began square dance lessons a couple of weeks later. They square danced until 1991 when they took a break to raise their six children. They returned to square dancing in the fall of 2007 and took their first round dance lessons in the spring of 2008. They began cueing in 2010 and started teaching soon after that.

They have their own Phase 2-4 club called Merry-Go-Rounders that meets on Sunday afternoons. They also cue and teach at Frank Morrell's Monday Night Rounds at the Wichita Downtown Senior Center. Additionally, they cue for a couple of Wichita area square dance clubs. They cue and teach levels 1 thru 4 in several rhythms including Waltz, Two-Step, Foxtrot, Jive, Slow Two-Step, Bolero, Rumba, and Cha Cha.

Kevin and Diane are members of ROUNDALAB, KRDA, ORDA, MRDA and ICBDA. They have attended five ROUNDALAB conventions and one Mini-Lab. They are members of the ROUNDALAB Phase II Round of the Quarter Committee. They also serve as Vice President of the KRDA and have taught and cued at several KRDA festivals. They have attended four National Square Dance Conventions and showcased at the 2014 Little Rock Arkansas convention. They have been the featured cuers for the annual Snowball Festival (Hays, KS) 2015-2023. In addition they also program the round dance hall and serve as the Cuer Host for the Kansas State Square Dance Convention.

Their choreography includes: Amazing Grace (P2 WZ), Sunrise, Sunset (P2 WZ), Traditions (P2 WZ), Rainbow Connection With Kermit (P2 WZ), I'll Be A Doggone Cowboy (P2 TS), American Bandstand Boogie (P2 TS), Climax (P3 WZ), Mi Confesion Basico (P3 RB), and The Bright Side Of Life (P4 FT).
